Please read this information closely before filling out the application.*

The attached application is for homes to be built in 2011 and 2012. Please note there are 7 pages to this application. There are also 4 places for the applicant(s) signature. Take your time when completing this application.

IMPORTANT FACTS YOU NEED TO KNOW.....

To qualify for consideration of a Habitat home, you must be able to answer "YES" to the following questions.

DO YOU NEED HOUSING?

- Do you live in housing with poor structure, plumbing, heating, or electrical systems - or lack enough space for all family members - or have to pay a high percentage of your income for rent - or living in public housing - or living with family or could your housing be considered "inadequate" in some other way?

CAN YOU PAY FOR THE HOME?

- Do you have enough steady and reliable income to afford a no-interest mortgage payment of approximately \$350 per month and still be able to pay your other monthly living expenses? Income includes wages (earned income), social security, SSI, disability, food stamps and child support. Habitat accepts all sources of legal, dependable income.
- Have you or your co-applicant been in your main job for at least six months?
- Do you have a "reasonable" credit history (have you paid most of your bills on time)?

ARE YOU WILLING TO PARTNER WITH PUTNAM COUNTY HFH?

- Are you willing to work at least 400 hours helping to build homes or doing other work as a partner with Habitat? And are you willing to attend 18 weeks of education classes along with a yearlong budget program? Preparing to become a Habitat Homeowner can be compared to having a part-time job.
- Are you able to pay \$1,100 in closing costs for your mortgage? (You will be expected to make regular payments toward these costs over a year) Closing costs are due in full when your home is completed, usually 18 months or more after selection.
- Have you lived OR worked in Putnam County for at least 12 months?
- Are you a legal resident of the United States?

There is also a MINIMUM income limit as you will be BUYING the home from Putnam County Habitat for Humanity. The minimum income required will depend upon the size of the home and family, the amount of your current debt, and other factors. We can determine that level after we process your application. Remember, we want your mortgage payment to be affordable so you are required to have a certain level of income.

Bring this application along with a \$20 non-refundable application fee to the Putnam County Habitat for Humanity office.
